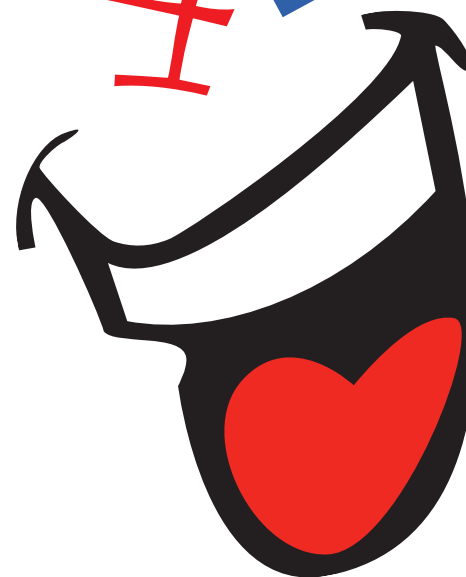

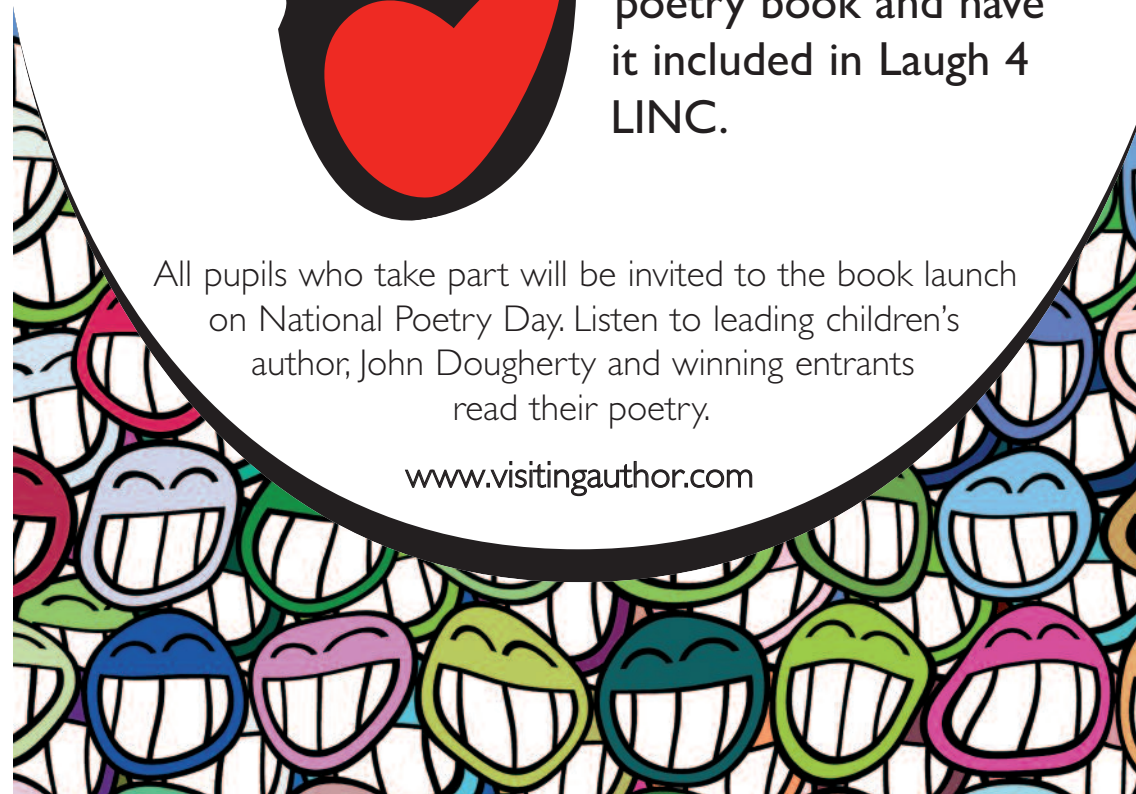

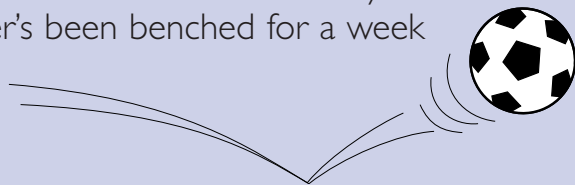
## **Our Teacher's a Football Fanatic**
