Paul Simpson, a father and much loved founder of A2B taxis of Cirencester, very sadly died at 52 years after contracting Covid-19 whilst being treated for cancer.

Paul, who fell ill with lymphoma in 2019 survived continuous chemotherapy for 18 months before catching the virus. He sadly passed away in Gloucestershire Royal on January 29, 2021.
